This exhibit will be JURIED by museum curator, Barbara Jones. It will be paired with "Rooted in Tradition: Art Quilts from the Rocky Mountain Quilt Museum." The curator wishes to show through the Art Quilts and Papercuttings both a connection and a departure from traditional forms. The papercuttings do not need to be literally related to quilts. Guild of American Papercutters members with paid 2010 membership are eligible to enter this exhibit with papercuttings which are original in design and execution.

Deadline for Submissions of Images: January 20, 2010

Ms. Barbara Jones will accept clear images for her jury process, including good quality hard copies, CD images, or slides. Please send an artist's bio and artist's statement when you submit your entries. Selected works and information on the artists will be shown on the museum website as soon as they are selected; notification will be the week of March 1, 2010. A specific announcement for the show will be mailed one month prior. There are no size limitations. (Artists can also send smaller framed papercuttings to be juried for the museum shop.) Deadline for Receipt of Selected Framed Papercuttings: July 1, 2010

Secure all identification on the back of each piece: Title, Artist's Name and Address, Phone, E-mail, Price (or Value if NFS). The museum will retain a 40% commission for exhibit and shop sales. Please include a check to Westmoreland Museum of American Art for return postage amount (same amount as for shipment of your work) to return pieces if they do not sell.
